Abuse Prevention Trainer Partnership

This comprehensive training for adults consists of a four-day workshop. Successful participants are then certified to deliver the *It's Not Your Fault* program to youth ages 12 and older. Teaching guide, curriculum and resources are provided in the training.

It's Not Your Fault Program

explores why abuse and neglect occur and where children and youth can go for help.

This program empowers young people to identify:

- definitions and implications of emotional, physical, and sexual abuse, neglect, and Internet sexual exploitation
- the impact of abuse on individuals and families
- definitions and implications of corporal punishment and discipline
- prevention and intervention strategies
- disclosures, and the legal requirements and protocols for reporting
- where to find support and community resources

A PowerPoint presentation and interactive activities support the delivery of this information.

The delivery model allows presentations to adapt to various timeframes through its modular format.

Training Details for Prevention Educator Partners

Cost: \$350 per person. [This training is being offered at a reduced cost as part of the launch of the program in our new format.] It includes training and the comprehensive "*It's Not Your Fault*" teaching binder – containing curriculum, resources, and activities.

It's Not Your Fault: Abuse Prevention

in-person training explores the definitions of the different types of abuse and neglect, the indicators and the effects on children and youth. Participants gain knowledge about the barriers and benefits to preventing abuse, and learn strategies to build safer relationships within organizations and communities. The training will also examine how to handle disclosures, the legal reporting requirements, and risk management strategies. Throughout the training, participants will also have the opportunity to prepare and practice facilitating the curriculum.
