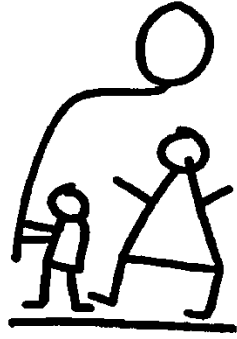

You will hear how this program is based on best practices, about the content of sessions, Project CHOICES' research findings, referral process and other related topics. The program works with women of childbearing age (ages 12 and up), who are sexually active but not currently pregnant and who drink alcohol.

Project CHOICES is offered through NorWest and Clinic and also provides programming at the Adolescent Parent Centre, Manitoba Youth Centre, TERF, to name a few.
