The **TeenAge Parent Program (TAPP)** is available to students 14-21 years of age who are pregnant and or parenting. TAPP offers both regular and modified programming for students who want to continue their high school education with their babies on site. Students take parenting courses, attend sessions with guest speakers, and receive Triple P, Rock & Read and Mother Goose training. The TAPP staff cares for the student's babies when students are in class. When students are not in class they are able to spend time with their children in the TAPP area.

Young Parents Connecting at Kildonan-East Collegiate provides a Healthy Baby plus drop in program which is offered after regular school hours. It is open to all young parents under the age of 21, either expecting or with a child(ren) 3 and younger. The program welcomes mothers and fathers alone or with their partners. Parents have the choice of working towards a course credit while attending group sessions and the program is designed to meet individual needs. Parents receive support from school counsellors and the program facilitator / out-reach worker. There is also a public health nurse and a community nutritionist on site.

RAP provides support for pregnant and parenting teens (under 18) to stay in school. Students attend an off campus Gordon Bell High School program called “Just learning.” Class sizes are smaller so students can work at their own pace and receive individual support while working on high school credits. RAP offers counselling services, support during pregnancy, information on nutrition and parenting, art classes, Aboriginal studies, sewing classes and presentations from guest speakers.

Villa Rosa is a residency program that provides a safe place to live during and after pregnancy that offers an education program to get back to or stay in school. Child Care is provided while students attend classes. Villa Rosa provides supports such as midwives, medical services, elders, counselling, pre-natal classes and 24 hour breastfeeding support.

Villa Rosa is staffed by the Interdivisional Student Services administered by the Winnipeg School Division. Education programming is available for students who are resident at Villa

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Rosa, living in their Post Natal Residence, or day students from the community. Instruction is available in major subjects from elementary to Grade 12.

The Post Natal Residence provides support and accommodation to eight women and their babies (under the age of 18 months) for 3 to 12 months while they are preparing to live independently.

APC is a non-residency high school program for pregnant and parenting teenagers with children up to 2 years. APC is affiliated with the Winnipeg Adult Education Center. APC provides an academic focused program. Students work on 30 credit programs or Mature Student programs.

Family Studies and Food & Nutrition courses are mandatory. Available student supports are a Teen Health Clinic, public health nurse, a Social Worker, Healthy Baby, Healthy Start for Mom and Me, Pre-natal classes, Building Student Support with Aboriginal Parents (BSSAP), Career Trek Mother's Project, and early literacy, speech and language and attachment initiatives. A Student Support Team monitors Student needs and attendance issues.

APCE provides bus tickets to qualifying students, breakfast, lunch and child care in 4 child care centres – Infant, Crawler, Toddler and Walker. Breastfeeding support is available. Students are transitioned into WAEC or other programs/high schools of their choice when they turn 21 or their children are 2 years old.

Students are required to take an introduction to parenting course as part of their electives, and are assigned a Family's First Worker in the 1<sup>st</sup> term. There is a licensed day care located in the school for children up to 2

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years of age. Students enrolled in the program are expected to be in the daycare at noon hour and anytime that they do not have classes.
